NOTES:

Satisfactory Progress: (notes 1 &2)

- Students must maintain a 2.0 minimum GPA (in all courses taken at Virginia Tech) to continue in the program.
- Students must maintain a 2.5 minimum in ITDS courses (This includes all courses with an ITDS pre-fix, and ARCH 1015-1016). If a student's GPA drops below a 2.5 in ITDS courses, some courses with below a 2.5 must be repeated to elevate the GPA to 2.5 before continuing in the degree. A grade of C- or better is required in the following ITDS studio courses: ITDS 2044, ITDS 2054, ITDS 3044, ITDS 3054, ITDS 4044, ITDS 4054.
- Foreign Language requirement: students who did not complete two units of foreign language in high school must earn six credits of foreign language to satisfy the foreign language requirement. These six credits will not count toward the overall 120 required for graduation.
- Some courses on this checklist may have prerequisite/corequisite requirements; please consult the university course catalog of check with your academic advisor
